

Cleared for Take-off: AeroEx Launches Toolkit Options for New EU Electronic Flight Bags Regulatory Compliance

The European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) requirements has introduced new provisions for commercial and non-commercial operators using installed or portable EFB’s, which transposes the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) standards. This new regulation is for the use of electronic flight bags and for the use of EFB applications with a failure condition classified as minor or below. Commercial Air Transport (CAT) operators are required to hold an operational approval for any Type B EFB application.

“Regulatory compliance is required, so missing a deadline means you remain grounded or unable to use your EFB. AeroEx can ensure your new EFB provisions can be met in a matter of weeks, not months, ensuring you are fully compliant by the July deadline,” said **Joel Hencks**, Managing Director at AeroEx. “Our toolkit offers the streamlined implementation method sought by flight operations, compliance, quality control and safety managers to ensure a seamless transition to the new requirements without taking the risk of not being able to use EFB applications after 9 July.”

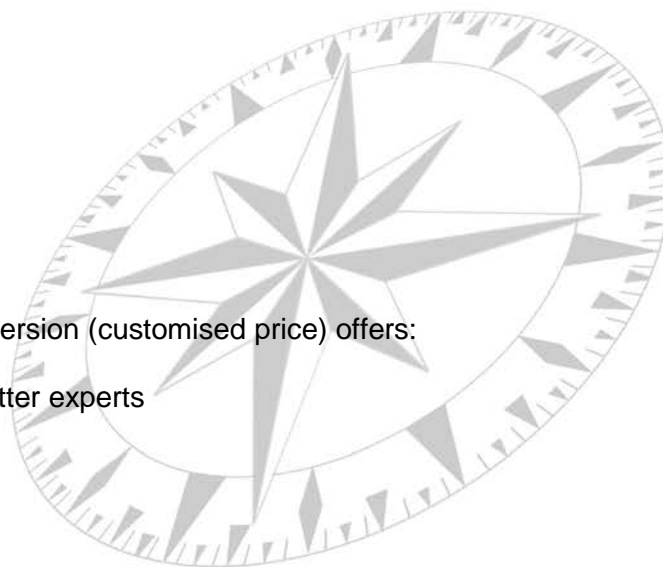

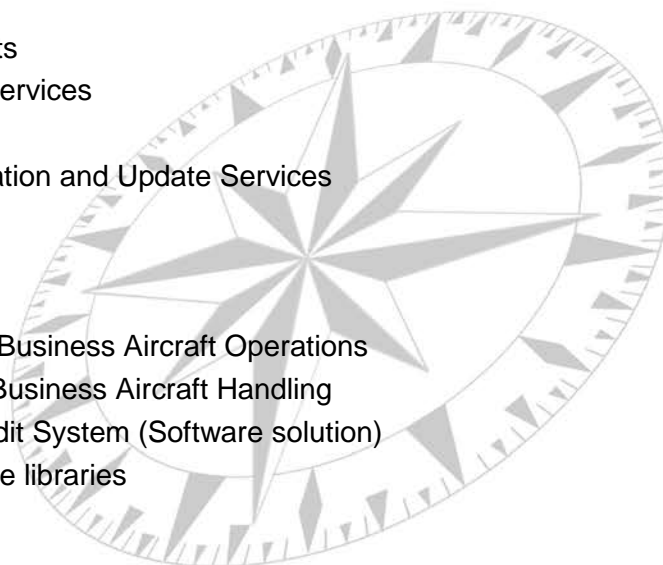
